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10X Essentials: Flu Season is Finally Over!

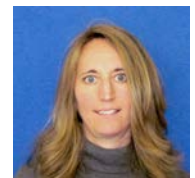
Flu A/B and RSV have finally taken leave from the GHS regions. Flu activity is low in Pennsylvania.

- **GML will stop the small viral panel ABRP (FluA/B RSV) for outpatients as on Monday May 16, 2016.**
- **Order RVPCR for all inpatient and outpatient testing.**
- **Collect a nasopharyngeal swab, NOT a nasal swab.**
- Place swab in UTM transport media.
- Store and transport UTM under refrigerated conditions



NEW: Geisinger Wyoming Valley Microbiology Launches On-site Blood Cultures

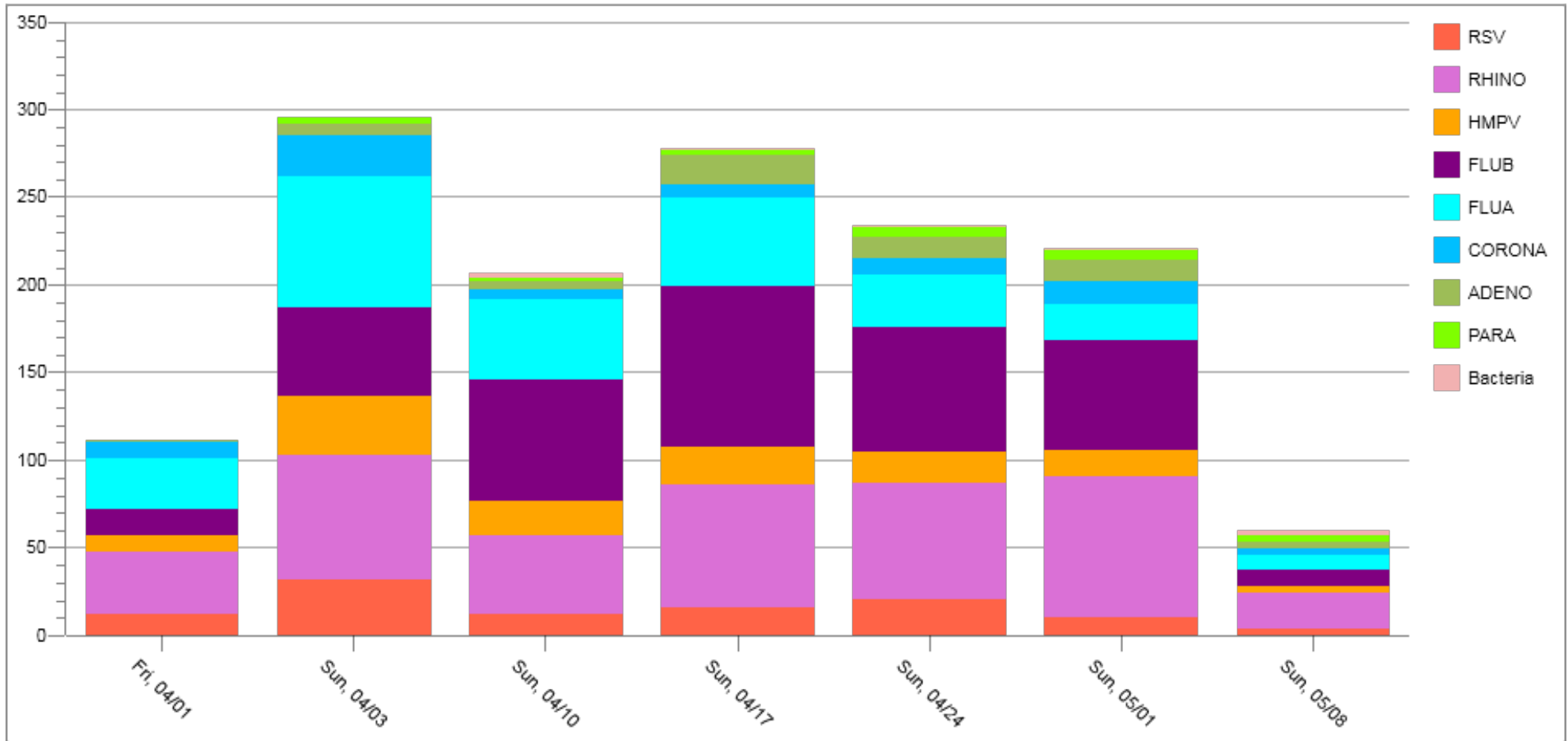
- Effective May 17th, 2016, Geisinger Wyoming Valley Laboratory will offer on-site incubation of GWV blood cultures in their brand new BACTEC FX instruments. Result delays due to previous courier transport to GMC for blood culture incubation will be eliminated, and as such, the reporting of positive Gram stains will be greatly expedited. Kudos to the GWV team for deployment of their new technology. Score one for GHS putting patients first! This deployment reflects the system commitment to *leading edge technology, close to home.*

Comprehensive Stool Cultures: Effective May 3rd, 2016 the STCUL test code (*Salmonella, Shigella, Campylobacter* only) was discontinued. In its place is STCOM, (Comprehensive Stool Culture for all bacterial stool pathogens). This change improves care for all our patients since it is impossible to clinically distinguish the bacterial cause of diarrhea prior to testing.
