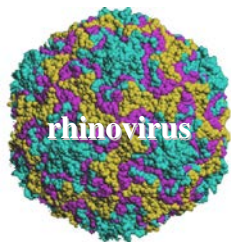
Influenza/Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) Report

- GML reports a stable proportion of RSV and only one influenza A virus identified for the week ending Dec 1, 2012.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports only **sporadic influenza activity in PA**, with widespread activity in New York and regional activity reported in Ohio.

Weekly Summary of Communicable Disease Activity (RESPView) 2012-2013 Respiratory Season Pathogen Surveillance

In CDC weeks 48, ending December 1, 2012, **rhinoviruses still predominate**, followed by RSV and parainfluenza viruses. **44% of samples submitted were positive** for at least one virus.

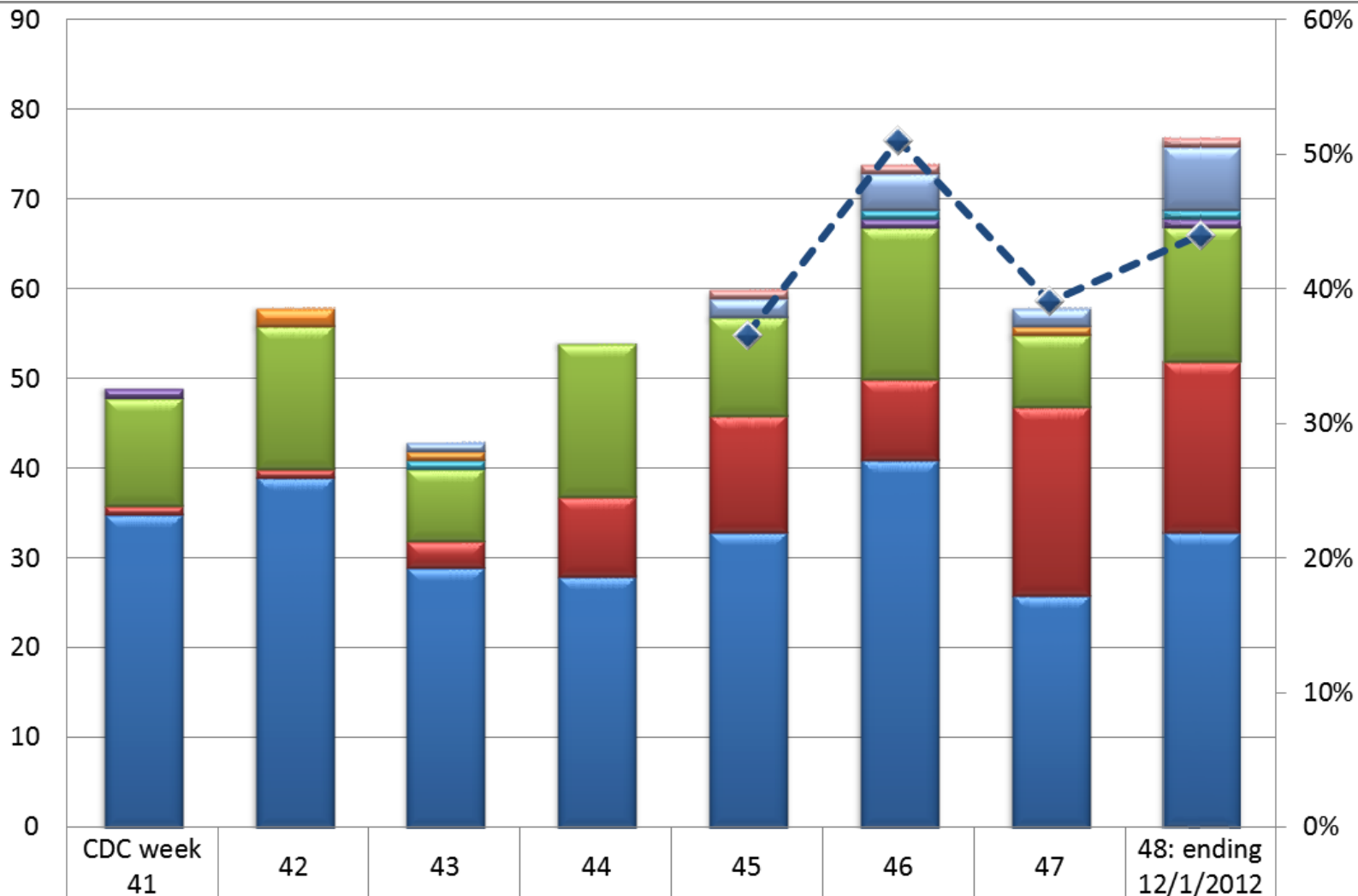
