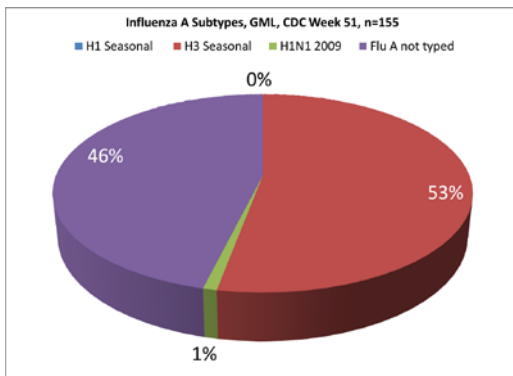

### Influenza/Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) Report

- GML reports continued increases in influenza virus activity this week, keeping with the trend for **influenza A, Seasonal H3 (98% of all those typed)** with rare Influenza A, H1N1 reported. Some influenza A viruses (46%) were not typed.
- Influenza B virus and RSV continues to circulate and RSV is increasing (refer to bar graph)

**ALERT: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports widespread influenza activity in 30 of 50 states.**

### Weekly Summary, RESPView Pathogen Surveillance 2012-2013

In CDC weeks 52, ending December 29, 2012, **influenza A predominates, followed by RSV and rhinoviruses. Coronaviruses are also on the rise.** The diversity of viruses is high with representative viruses from all viral groups. Another season high of **63% of samples submitted were positive** for at least one virus. ***Mycoplasma pneumonia* continues to circulate at low levels.**

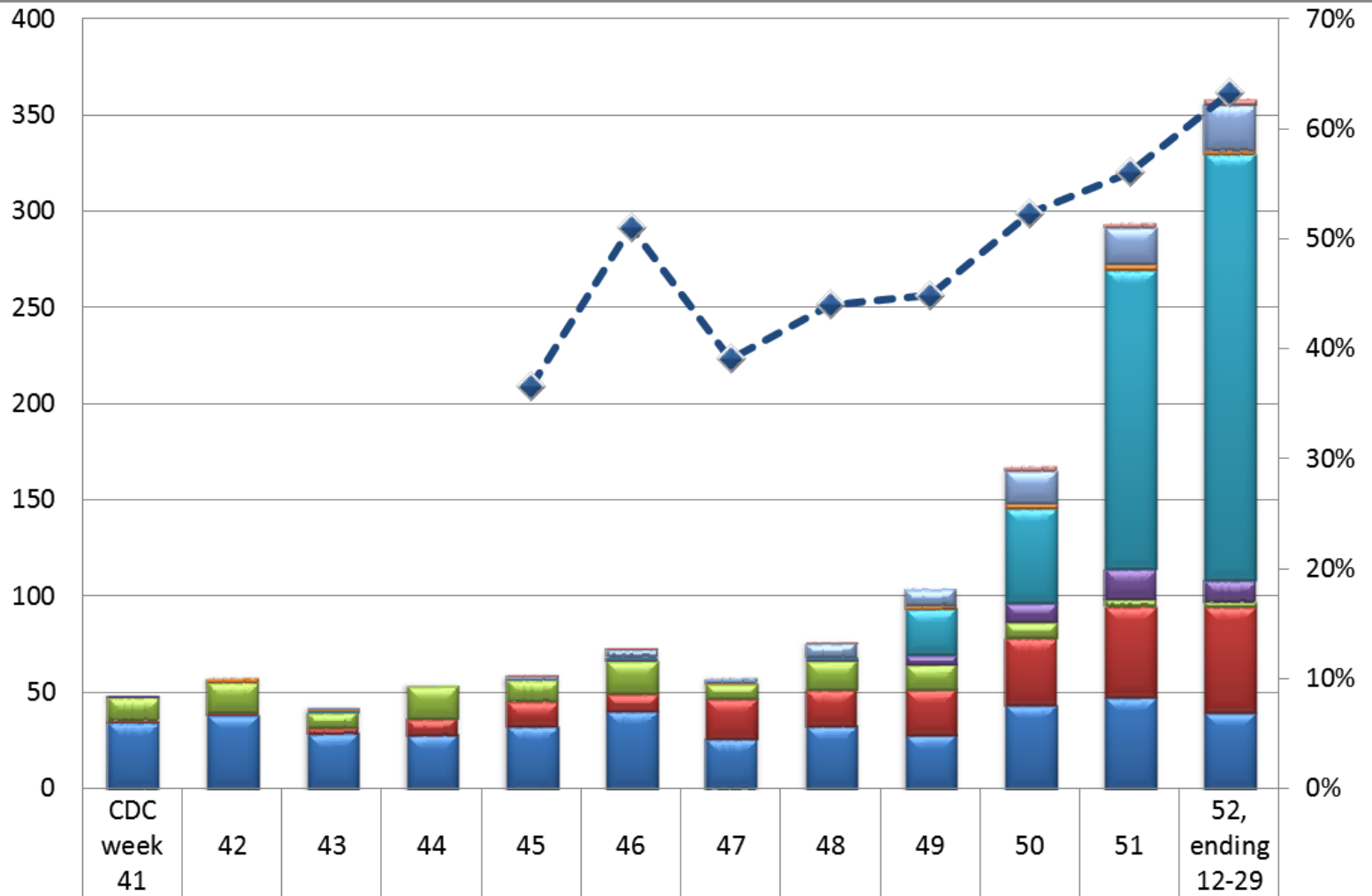
