NEW: Respiratory Pathogen Result Notification Will Discontinue on Jan 30, 2019.

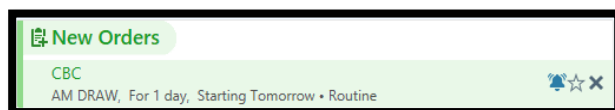
Effective January 30, 2019, positive respiratory pathogen results (RPPCR and ABRP) will no longer be considered critical values for inpatients, emergency department, and observation rooms. Notification of these results were discontinued for outpatients several years ago and in a continued effort to respond to provider's requests, we will no longer notify inpatient providers of these results. Providers are able to request notification in EPIC if these (or any results) are needed.

NEW: Group A Strep Result Notification Will Discontinue on Jan 30, 2019.

Effective January 30, 2019, positive group A strep results (Group A Strep PCR/GASPCR and Rapid antigen/throat) will no longer be considered critical values. Notification of these results will be discontinued in response to provider's requests. Again, providers are able to request notification in EPIC if these (or any results) are needed.

NEW: Receive Push Notifications for Results

1. When placing an order for a test, click the bell icon to request a push notification (a colored bell indicates that a notification has been requested. If the bell is not colored, no notification has been requested)



2. If you are not the ordering user or wish to request a push notification, you can also request a notification by selecting the bell icon from the Nursing Kardex, RN Acknowledge Report, or the Orders (84-hour) Report



NOTE:

In 2018, expansive changes to electronic bed management dashboards occurred in a collaboration between system bed management, laboratory medicine, and infection control.

Also, Epic was restructured to enable abnormal test results flagging ! to occur for all positive Microbiology results.

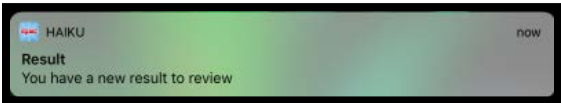
